Champagne Cocktail c. 1862

prosecco, blood orange liqueur, lemon, pomegranate, cinnamon, chai

### PINEAPPLE SKIES

French 75 c. 1915

vodka, pineapple sambucha, pineapple oleo, lemon

### FRENCH TIPS\*

Ramos Gin Fizz c. 1888

gin, cointreau, lemon, house grenadine, half and half, topo chico, egg white

### W TREMONT BRAMBLE\*

Highland Bramble c. 1980

scotch, lemon, honey blackberry and lavender liqueur, amaro, egg white

### SPRING FLING

Negroni c. 1919

gin, cointreau, cappalletti, st. germaine, lillet blanc

### IT'S A VIBE

Rum Swizzle c. 1924

bourbon, pineapple rum, lemon, falernum, pineapple juice

### PALOMA DE LA PARRILLA

Paloma c. 1860

barrel rested tequila, grilled grapefruit juice cordial, grapefruit shrub, mineral water, dehydrated lime, sea salt, mezcal mist

### PARA TODO MAL, MEZCAL

Mai-Tai c. 1934

mezcal, rum, orgeat, serrano infused agave, lime, oj splash

### PARM TO TABLE

Dirty Martini c. 1800's

Parmesan cheese washed gin, local tomato water, basil infused vermouth, dehydrated tomato paste

### MELONCHOLY

Perfect Manhattan c. 1860's

rye whiskey, amaro, melon infused dolin blanc, cocchi di torino, krupnik bitters

### THE UNCLE EDDY

Old Fashioned c 1880

waygu fat-washed bourbon, slow ginger syrup, buckspice bitters, king cube, cold smoked

### THE ZEPPELIN PICKLEBACK

Shot and Back c. 1950's

molecular pickle juice sphere, rotating spirit
